

Milo Adventist Academy

\$1000 Scholarship Program

PURPOSE: To recognize and reward the outstanding achievement and lifestyle of nine students within the Oregon Conference who could attend Milo the following school year.

AVAILABILITY: Nine \$1000 scholarships will be awarded. Distribution will generally follow these guidelines:

- 2 students in eight or nine-grade schools
- 4 sophomores in ten-grade schools
- 2 current eleventh grade Milo students

Also for grades 9-12:

- 1 student from public school/non-SDA Christian/out-of-OR Conf school

CRITERIA: Students must be nominated by their school administration based on the following criteria:

- If Gr 9+, a cumulative GPA of 3.75+ in all academic subjects
- If 8th grader, 95% A's in all academic subjects for 7th and 8th grade
- Leadership positions held and evaluation of performance
- Participation in church/community service programs or organizations
- Outstanding achievements or awards
- Evaluation of mental, social, emotional, and spiritual maturity
- Composite Achievement Test Scores at 85th percentile or above on current year.

In addition, the student must submit an original essay which expresses his/her philosophy of life. This should include personal goals and objectives. Limit 250 words. (Printed or typed)

DEADLINE FOR NOMINATION: May 1

PROCESS OF SELECTION: A Scholarship Committee will be comprised of the Curriculum/Academic Standards Committee and School Administration.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION: Academic achievement (45%), leadership background/potential (20%), school or community involvement (20%), and essay (15%).

PRESENTATION OF AWARDS: A Milo representative will present the award at the student's graduation and/or recognition program. Monies will be applied to the student's account proportionally at the end of Fall and Spring terms.
