

## More about Milo Horse Program

The stables are located on the Milo Adventist Academy campus.

In 1997, the first two horses were received from Big Lake Youth Camp to board during the winter months. This was the beginning of the program. The stables now include a number of Big Lake Youth Camp horses, several horses owned by the Haleys, and several privately-owned horses. The horse stables provide not only recreational activity for students, but also a learning experience.

Students who decide to board their horses are charged \$75.00 to cover boarding expenses (food and general care). Farrier and vet charges are additional. A student's horse will not be shared by other students. Only the Big Lake Youth Camp horses are shared by students.

Caregivers for the horses include one or two student workers and Mr. and Mrs. Haley, the sponsors. Care is provided for the horses during home leaves and vacations.

## What is Needed From You

**Riding Release** – signed by parent/guardian and student

**Fees** – Depending on your participation in the horse program, a fee will be charged each month.

• **\$40 / month** for use of the Big Lake Youth Camp horses with unlimited riding

• **\$75 / month** for privately-owned horses. This fee covers feed. It does not cover farrier or vet bills.

• **\$5 / ride** for those not paying a monthly fee. This will be automatically charged to your bill at the end of each month if it is \$25 or under.

**Immunization Records** – for all privately-owned horses.



## Earn Class Credit

Class credit is offered for \$500 per semester. Participants must belong to the horse program. For further information, contact Kirk or Lynda Haley.

In the event of bad weather, the class will be held in a covered riding arena at Hestehaven Ranch.

## Riding Release

It is required that all participants in the horse program wear helmets when riding any horse. This includes privately-owned horses boarded on Milo Adventist Academy property.

We, the undersigned, accept full responsibility for the participant's actions and results of said actions and will make reparations for any damage done to a person(s), animal(s), or property not our own.

## What will be Provided

• Hay

• Grain

• Lodging for horse(s)

• **Immunizations** – Additional fee charged for privately-owned horse(s).

• **Worming medication** – Additional fee charged for privately-owned horses.

For those interested, Hestehaven Ranch is located approximately 10 miles from the Milo campus and has an indoor riding arena. The owners of Hestehaven Ranch offer riding lessons for a fee, which varies depending on whether you have private or group lessons.
